REENGAGING YOUR STUDENTS:
GROWING THEIR MOTIVATION AND ACHIEVEMENT

Classroom teachers and their students have endured isolation, personal struggle, and in many cases, interruptions to how we “do school.” Teachers everywhere report that their students have “changed.” This course is designed to help teachers motivate their students, to reengage them, and to build back the stamina that seems to have been lost. Practical strategies that can be implemented with ease will help teachers not only recharge their students but also to breathe life into their classroom climate.

This is a hybrid course with some online work/activity/collaboration.

Teachers will:

- **Identify ways to help students put effort into their work and persist through challenges**
- Grow strategies that support students in framing questions and understanding the *why* of learning
- **Understand what happens when a student’s amygdala feels “hijacked.”**
- See how furniture arrangements and classroom climate improve learning opportunities
- **Create teaching and assessment tools that motivate students and promote content mastery and skill-building**
- Learn techniques to grow student-student and teacher-student relationships

Teachers will earn 3 graduate credits and 67.5 PDPs for this course.
